## 1 **21 NCAC 66.0211 VETERINARY TELEMEDICINE** is proposed for adoption as follows:

- a. A veterinarian may provide veterinary care via telemedicine to any patient(s) located in the State after establishing a Veterinary-Client-Patient-Relationship (VCPR). No person shall practice veterinary telemedicine except a veterinarian within the context of a VCPR. A VCPR cannot be established by any electronic means.
- b. The delivery of veterinary medical services through telemedicine is the practice of veterinary medicine.
  The practice of veterinary medicine occurs where the patient(s) is located at the time telemedicine
  technologies are used.
- 9 c. Veterinarians practicing telemedicine shall be held to the same standard of care as veterinarians providing 10 in-person medical care. There is not a separate standard of care applicable to telemedicine.
