Minutes of the meeting of the State
Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners,
Wrightsville N.C. July, 2, 1909.

Meeting called to order by President of Board,
Dr. Adam Fishes.

Members present were: Dr.
Fishes, Carrol, Ashcraft, Roberts.

Minutes of last meeting were read and
approved.

A verbal communication was presented
by W. A. Edmund who appeared
before the Board to ask for a temporary
certificate for M. D. Edmunds.

Motion was made and carried that
he be required to stand the examination.

W. A. Edmund was notified of the action
of the Board, but knowing his deficiencies
he did not attempt the examination.

Report of Sec. - Treas. showed a balance of
\$5.72 received from the returning Sec. Treas. the
year before.

Motion made and carried that the
old officers be re-elected.

Motion made and carried, that owing
to the inability of Dr. M. J. Ragland
to attend the meeting of Board and having
paid examination fee of \$10.⁰⁰, he be
allowed to stand the examination at
Charlotte, N.C. before Drs. Ashcraft and
Fishes at some time suitable to them.

 Materia Medica and Therapeutics: Watt Ashcroft
 Bacteriology, Pathology and Obstetrics: G. A. Roberts.
