



All On-line CE Accepted for 2020 ONLY

In response to the current COVID-19 Pandemic, the Governor's state of emergency orders and stay at home orders, the NCVMB will suspend the requirement that only 10 hours of CE may be obtained via online learning. Therefore, for the year 2020 ONLY, Veterinarians and Registered Veterinary Technicians may obtain their CE completely online/virtually (both interactive and non-interactive) if necessary to complete their required hours. As a reminder, as part of the 20 hours of CE requirement, 2 hours must be dedicated to controlled substance CE per the STOP ACT. If conditions allow and the stay at home order is rescinded by the Governor, we still encourage members to attend in person CE if possible.

We continue to recommend that essential services ONLY be provided – this is to ensure the health and safety of yourself, your staff, your families and the public as well as conserving critical PPE. It is the responsibility of each individual veterinarian to determine if a procedure is necessary and essential.
